



Frequently Asked Questions

Who can apply?

Applicants should have a master's degree in architecture. Equivalent work experience or self-learning may also be acceptable. Applicants are required to demonstrate talent as a designer as well as the ability and motivation to complete the programme successfully.

How much is tuition?

Is the UAA accredited?

The UAA is recognized by INTBAU but is currently not accredited by national accreditation organizations. Graduates receive an INTBAU certified Graduate Certificate in Designing Architecture.

How many ECTS credits is the programme?

The UAA is currently not eligible for ECTS credits. The total workload over the full year is equivalent to 60 ECTS credits.

Are dorms included?

Items such as laptops, accommodation, and living costs are extra to tuition fees. You may also incur additional costs for: study trips, materials, photocopying, printing, library subscriptions, etc.

Can I join for only one term?

The curriculum has been designed to work cohesively over the two terms. Therefore joining for one term is not possible.
